

Exporting pictures from Qx3

These notes give some help and advice on using pictures obtained with Qx3.

Why would you need to export?

- Put a picture into word to print on ohp acetate. (You can print straight from Qx3, but this would give you more options).
- Save a picture so that it can be used in a written report or presentation(this could be used in Word or PowerPoint)



First get the focus and take the photo, by clicking on the camera button.

The picture you have just taken can now be seen in the preview window.

Go to the main window by

clicking the arrow.

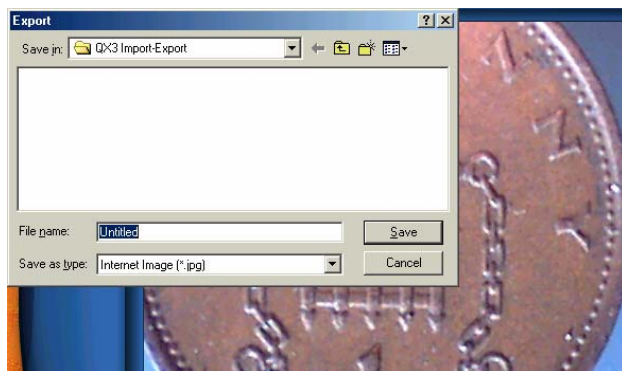


Here you can alter the picture or print it etc. To make it available to other programmes you need to export it. Click on the export button.

A dialog box will appear. You need to choose where you want to save the picture and what you call it! It is best to use something logical, so this would be called "1penny" and saved with

the metals topic work. It up to you where and what you call your work, but it makes things a lot easier to find if you have a system.

In Word, PowerPoint etc, you should then be able to go to insert, picture, from file, and choose your picture to drop in.
